
When a person plays a 'solo' game of skill, where he/she is the only 'human' involved, then it is important for them to record and measure their results, as this is the only way to monitor whether they are improving or not.

This is what the WIZBridge+ Statistics are all about ... with a little extra ... as we also show you how you compare with the rest of the WIZBridge+ community.

And please be assured, 100% guaranteed, that no-one, and we mean no-one, will ever see, or have access to, your personal statistics *

The first thing to remember is that **WE ONLY MONITOR HANDS THAT HAVE BEEN PLAYED UNDER STRICT RULES!**

(This is for obvious reasons. Playing in Practice mode, you can see all 4 hands, take tricks back, and skip hands you don't like the look of .. all of which can favourably distort your results)




PLEASE NOTE: These statistics ONLY count completed matches of 8 hands

OK - Let's start.

We keep separate track of your results for each level, and at each you can see

- The number of matches played
- Your last match score
- Your average for that level
- Whether your average has moved up or down after the last match

In order to give you a 'flow' of your recent performance, and yet make the graphs visually readable, after you complete 20 matches, we move the last 10 to the left, and continue from 11 onwards.




Community Average

As well as 'competing' against yourself, and trying to improve your average, we also let you see how you compare with the rest of the WIZBridge+ community (Pink band)

Please Note: The community average is calculated daily, at 6am GMT. As this is calculated from thousands of records, it will show only tiny variations from day to day.


The pie chart on the left shows you the percentage of matches that you've completed or abandoned.



And the chart on the right shows you the percentage of hands played out of the abandoned matches. (The higher number in green means you've abandoned games earlier)

And finally two graphs to show you your historical statistics.

The time span is shown at the bottom of the chart, so a full chart represents your last 200 matches played at this level.



Statistics for statistics sake are a waste of computing effort. We have put them here for your benefit. Monitor them, and try to use them to;

- Improve your match score
- Reduce the number of abandoned games
- And finally, there are separate dedicated Statistics for Duplicate

The only part of your statistics that <u>we</u> use is your average, which is used, together with everyone else's, to calculate the community average. YOUR NAME IS NOT ASSOCIATED WITH THIS!

Periodically we will publish the names of users who have returned exceptionally good results on a match, or have shown a dramatic improvement in their rolling average.
